Housing Information

Beijing Language and Culture University (BLCU)

Students will be housed in double rooms with other Alliance students in one of the new International Student Dorms. Rooms include: two single beds, two desks, two chairs, small book shelves, cabinets, desk lamps, TV, and air-conditioning, and a private bathroom.

Bed linens, towels and washcloths are provided by the dorm. There are washing machines on each floor.

Fudan University

Students are housed in Tonghe International Apartments across the street from the back (or north) gate of the University. The apartment size will vary between two and three bedrooms. The two bedroom apartments will be shared by one Alliance student and one Fudan University student, while the three bedroom apartments will be shared by two Alliance students and one Fudan student. The apartments include a bathroom, kitchen, and a furnished bedroom, with desk, desk lamp, closet space, and a remote control heating/air-conditioning unit. The furnished common areas include a TV, filtered water dispenser, refrigerator, gas burners in the kitchen, and a small washing machine.

The bedrooms also include sheets, pillows, and a comforter. No towels are provided.

Shanghai University of Finance and Economics (SUFE)

Students will be housed in double rooms with Chinese roommates in the International Student Dormitory located near the center of campus and very close to Alliance classrooms. Each Alliance student will share a double room with a SHUFE university student. Rooms include: two single beds, two desks, desk lamps, two thermoses for boiled water (available on first floor of dormitory), closet space with a lockbox for each student, remote control heater/air-conditioner, bathroom with shower, and a balcony. Hot water is available one hour after turning on the hot water heater located in the bathroom. The water heater holds approximately 15 minutes worth of hot water.

Sheets, pillows and a comforter are provided; towels are not.

Telephones and Internet Access

All students will have a telephone in their dorm room or apartment and will be assigned a phone number after they arrive. Students are responsible for their own phone charges. The Alliance recommends that students consider purchasing a cell phone after they arrive in Beijing or Shanghai. The Resident Director will provide information during orientation about how and where to purchase a cell phone.

Students are strongly encouraged to bring their laptops. The dorms or apartments which house Alliance students all have the capability to set up internet access. Students may also use the computer labs on campus for a small hourly fee.

During orientation, students will receive more information on how to set up internet in their rooms. There is a small set up fee and a monthly access fee for internet use in your dorm or apartment.
