Chinese Language Background *(to be completed by all students)*

No prior language study is required for entrance into Alliance programs except the Fudan Intensive Language program. For the Intensive Language program, two semesters of prior Chinese language study are required. Upon taking a placement exam after arrival, students will be placed into the appropriate language level, beginning through advanced.

I have or will have completed _____ semesters of college-level Chinese language study by the time I enroll in the Alliance program.

Students must have completed one business course and one economics course prior to arrival in China. If business is not available at your school, two economics courses are required instead. The elective course **International Money and Finance** also requires students to have completed an introduction to finance course. The remaining elective courses do not have additional prerequisites.

Our 3 credit internship option is also available, but spots are limited. If you choose the internship as your elective course, you must choose an alternate course (mark with a “2”) in case you are not accepted into one of the limited internship spots.
4. For students wishing to earn 18 credits, choose *two* additional courses for 3 credits each. Our 3 credit internship option is also available, but spots are limited. Please mark two of the courses below with a “1” for your first choices. If you choose the internship as one of your two courses, you must choose an alternate course (mark with a “2”) in case you are not accepted into one of the limited internship spots.
